We hope that this month you will renew your AIP membership and update your profile on our new and improved website.

You may recall that due to COVID, AIP-TW wasn't providing services during much of 2020, and as a result, your Board decided to automatically extend all member expiration dates ultimately by two years. Therefore, most people currently have expiration dates out to late-2023 and no one had to pay dues for these 2-year renewals. Only recently have some members been advised of their membership expiration and some of you have recently renewed.

The simplest way to accomplish this member profile update is for members to go through a full renewal process. Therefore, all volunteers and some other member categories will have their renewal date reset to January 31, 2023 and this will result in an update to your profile as you complete the renewal.

- Volunteers will be notified of their current Background Check status so that they only renew their Background Checks if those are also expiring.
